Up Dates from April's Meeting

1. Guest Speaker: Acting Police Chief Schauland – topics discussed

- Speed trailer – only does traffic count. The trailer is being rotated around the 5 worse areas. They are using selective enforcement.
- Stop signs at intersections of Kirby/Morris and Kirby and Kirkland. Results we now have 2 new 4 way stops in the area.
- Recommended a study of the traffic flow in the area.
- 3 main roads in the area, Crill, Laurel, and River will be difficult to get the city to change these or add stop signs because of their high traffic volume.
- 73 traffic tickets have been handed out in the historic area since Jan. 1st.
- 68 burglary calls
- What to do for the future? Selective enforcement best now secondary to the city resources that are available.

2. Treasures report – \$2100 in account. Money went out for water deposit, electric bill and new locks on building.

3. Title is clear. Mr. Campbell is working on applying for grants to match renovation funds

4. Crime Comm. – No new business.

Since meeting several small break-ins have occurred in the area.

5. Home Tour Comm. – Has a full schedule. Help is still needed.

6. Nuisance ordinances – we do not have any in Palatka. Mr. Campbell asked if anyone comes across these to please get copies from other cities. Also asked for a volunteer to help with this.

7. Clean up Day – 4/28/01 outside community center. Big success.

8. New signs for the neighborhood are in the works. Examples presented. Tax increment money will buy these.

9. Certified Local Government Meeting was attended by the Mayor. He is very interested in this and is going to pursue it.
